

GROOMING REPORT

December 28, 2025

We have cleared Lower Marshal, Westfork of Clearwater, North Marshal, all of Henry, Fawn to Elsina, Up Elsina, around the Safety Hut and down Deer Creek.

We helped Deer Creek, but we do not have enough snow for a second pass.



Elsina - December 24 1

Work continued on Friday and Saturday. Tree removal and grooming is slow. The groomers have cleared and groomed Lower Marshall, West Fork of the Clearwater, Mid-Marshall, North Marshall and Mount Henry.

Grooming and tree removal has taken place on Elsina, the Safety hut and Deer Creek.

NOTE: until we get more snow, no more time will be spent on Deer Creek. It has spring washes and trees placed during the decommission showing. The Northfork of Placid to Jocko Road and Fawn to the Fawn to Archibold down Archibold to West Side Bypass should be done today (Sunday).

Yesterday (Saturday), Cotton Wood to Rich Ranch and out to Monture were groomed. We are blocking the beginning of the trails with snow berms to prevent wheeled travel and we are making sure

the signs are open restricting travel to snow machines.

The Garnet Groomer will be moved this week to the Garnet Trailhead. BLM is sending a crew to remove downed trees on their system. They do report a lack of snow. We can only do what we can do. We have made good time with the machines and saws. Seeley Lake Ranger Station Personnel have been out on the trails cutting out the areas, we now have open. Crews are set to start cutting Monday on the west side and a groomer will start on Rice Ridge Monday, as well.

Over all we have made good time even with low snow amounts. We can certainly use more volunteers.
